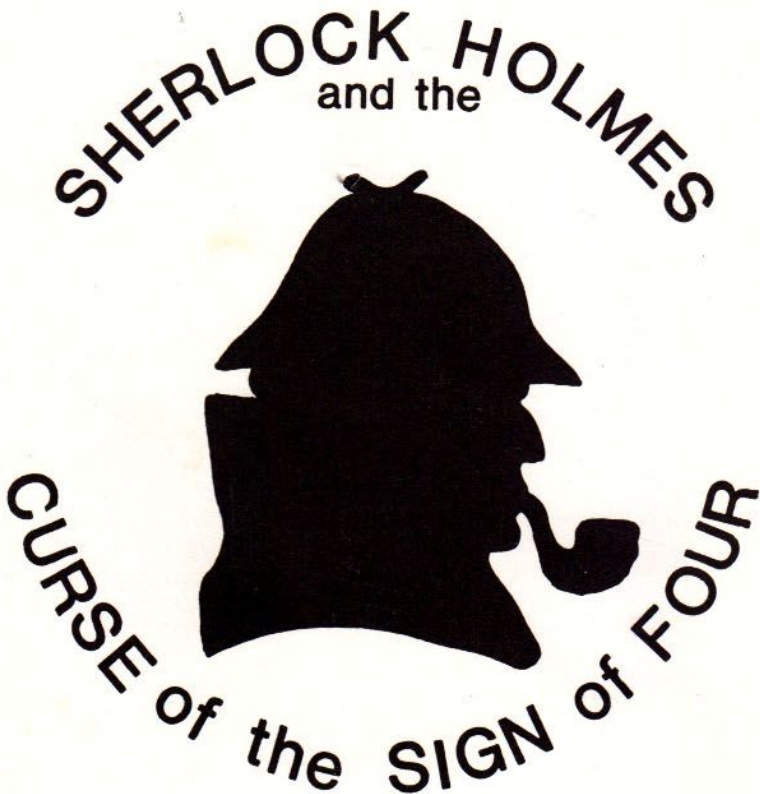

WHO'S WHO IN THE CAST



ANN S. MOYLES (*Director*) Now, in her second year at Prep, Mrs. Moyles is back to lend her talents to "The Curse of the Sign of Four". A graduate of Marywood College, she directed last year's "The Mouse That Roared", and "The Music Man". Mrs. Moyles has also appeared in local summer stock and with the Marywood Cinematography Club. She was also director of Drama at Dunmore High School. Mrs. Moyles resides in Dunmore with her husband and two children.

SUZANNE N. FITZSIMMONS (*Production Coordinator*) Mrs. Fitzsimmons began her work with the Players in "You Can't Take It With You", then moved on to work on "My Fair Lady", "The Mouse That Roared", and last year's "The Music Man". Mrs. Fitzsimmons brings forth her ability for organization in her position as production coordinator. Mrs. Fitzsimmons, a biology and chemistry teacher, holds a bachelor's degree from Marywood College, and a master's degree from Boston University.

HANK HEWITT (*Technical Director*) Even though this is Mr. Hewitt's first production with the Players, he is not a newcomer to the stage. While in college he appeared in "A Lion in Winter" and "A Christmas Carol". On the junior high school level, he directed many of the Prep Players during their days at St. Paul's. He has received his bachelors and masters degrees in philosophy and education from the University of Scranton. He is a welcome addition to the Scranton Prep Players.

JENNIFER JORDAN (*Stage Manager*) Jennifer, now in her second year with the Players, moves into the position of stage manager, having acted as assistant stage manager for "The Music Man".
